Lynn Alleva Lilley is an American photographer born in Washington, DC and currently living in Silver Spring, MD. At the core of her photographic work is connection with place and nature. Her work is also inspired by poetry, music, painting and science and she has a particular interest in the photobook as a uniquely intimate way of presenting her photographs. Her first photobook, *Tender Mint*, includes photographs made in Jordan (2011-2014) which reveal feelings of displacement, loss, adaptation and home. The photographs in her recent photobook, *Deep Time* (May 2019), present the mysterious life and world of the Atlantic horseshoe crab, *Limulus polyphemus*. Ms. Alleva Lilley began as a self-taught photographer and later studied with photographer Terri Weifenbach in Maryland and Washington, D.C. She has created work while living in Kyrgyzstan, Jordan, Maryland and Delaware.
