

Starting from Alison Knowles' piece *Bread and Water*,

I created a three video installation - Roggenbrott - that
aims to investigate collaborative production in arttaking the viewer through another's practice. Images
of the river are incorporated as a metaphor between a
studio practice and a collaborative open practice - with

the journey along the Hudson River, which geographically connects the two artists, energized by a series of resonances. Baking bread together at Knowles' studio, in upstate New York, the focus of investigation is Knowles' concept - where images of bread double as specific topographical profiles of rivers.
