Eleni Mylonas is a multidisciplinary artist, her work moves across media and forms, including photography, sculpture, painting, geometric abstraction, video, and performance. She had solo exhibitions at the MoMA PS1; BENAKI Museum in Athens; Françoise Heitsch Gallery in Munich; Ileana Tounta Contemporary Art Center in Athens; Zoumboulakis Gallery in Athens; and Foundation for Hellenic Culture in New York. Her work has been shown at various Museums and galleries including, the Queens Museum in New York; Ellis Island Museum in New York, MOMus Museum in Thessaloniki; EMST Museum in Athens; Shiva Gallery in New York; Museum of Contemporary Art in Crete; Schorpf Gallery in Chicago; Konica Plaza in Tokyo; and the Alternative Museum in New York. Eleni's work has been exhibited in several Biennales, including, the Thessaloniki Biennale, Destroy Athens, and Cannakale walk in Oskabruck, Germany.
