## Noyes Signature Artist Exhibition: 2017

## Free Opening Reception: Second Friday, October 13, 6 – 8 pm

The Noyes Signature Artist Members Exhibition is an annual event that showcases recent work by our Signature Artists – a juried group of outstanding artists from throughout New Jersey and the surrounding Mid-Atlantic region. The exhibition presents a wide array of styles and mediums, including mixed-media, painting, ceramics, and furniture.

Highlights include Kristin Myers' An Open Sea, a meticulously crafted line drawing, and an homage to

the vastness of the ocean. Bette Blank's I Cannot Tell a Lie... adds an element of humor as she takes on

current social issues with a lighthearted touch. Eileen Kennedy's painting, *Dona Nobis Pacem*, in the labor-intensive medium of egg tempera was inspired by the pure colors and narrative style of the Renaissance masters. Ken Karlic's spontaneous brushstrokes in *Windows and a Door* "find beauty in the structures and the grit of everyday life." Marie Natale's watercolor, *Fall Snow*, captures the subtleties of light and vibrant colors of the landscape. The sculptural *Mesa Blanc*, a finely crafted table in maple by Glen Guarino, explores the boundaries between function and aesthetics.
