Down the tubes You can't force people to check out your work, but Brooklyn-based artist Kathyne Hall has made it nearly impossible not to gawk. For her portable installation **Tubisms: Cars** Hall asks random drivers if they'll stay parked as she twists 50-foot tubes through their car windows to provoke and surprise unsuspecting passersby. Her next performance-installation is in Long Island City on Sat 14 at 5pm (46th and Jackson Aves, across from P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center; kathynehall.com/events). Hall draws from the likes of Christo and Jean-Claude of *The Gates*, but admits her work is a little harder to see, as it only lasts as long as her host is willing to stay parked—generally about two hours.
