Lynn Alleva Lilley is an American photographer born in Washington, DC and currently living in Silver Spring, MD. At the core of her work is a strong connection to nature and place. Her creative process is inspired by poetry, music, painting and science and she has a particular interest in the photobook as a uniquely intimate way of presenting her photographs. Her first photobook, *Tender Mint*, includes photographs made in Jordan over a three year period which reveal feelings of displacement, loss, adaptation and other-worldly beauty in the context of Jordan. The photographs in her recent photobook, *Deep Time*, present the mysterious life and world of the ancient Atlantic horseshoe crab, Limulus *polyphemus*. Ms. Alleva Lilley lived with her family in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan during 2016-2018 where she continued to photograph. Upon returning home to Silver Spring, Maryland, she continues to create a body of work entitled "il nido (the nest)" in the woods of Sligo Creek near her home. Ms. Alleva Lilley began as a self-taught photographer more than 25 years ago and later studied with photographer Terri Weifenbach who became an important mentor.
