A.I.R will exhibit wood sculpture by Ann Pachner. This will be her second solo exhibition in New York City. She has received grants from the National Endowment for the Arts (1985) and the New York Foundation for the Arts (1988).

The artist's experience with these works has been part of her process of moving towards a powerful enlivenment which is receptive, embracing and compassionate.

The viewer is welcomed by a doll.

A landscape of tables stands in the large gallery. A shape rests on these tables. It could be a head, hair, mountain, skirt, something being covered. They sit in an ambiguous space a weight resting on clear glass. The glass delineates space or is a window.

Resting at one's feet is a weighty piece entitled "Dalphina", which draws one to an earth bound space.

Turning, the black and white streams entitled "Grandmothers" confronts in an unsettling way.
