We will hand out pdfs of some poetry, and the Shklovsky and Tolstoy essays. We will also provide excerpts from **The Idiot** and **Anna Karenina**, however, students are encouraged to read these two novels over the summer in their totality if they are interested. If so, please be sure to read at least two of the works from each author.
