Black Pond Supplies:

Wear painting clothes or bring a smock

- 1lb plasticine (any color): Dick Blick link below. (but you can purchase anywhere)

- Kitchen knife/ Dinner knife: to cut plasticine
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- White Drawing or Sketch paper 18x24" (large): 15-20 sheets, from a pad or loose (heavier than newsprint)

Prepare 5 of the pieces of 18x24" White Drawing or Sketch Paper before class meets:

- Gessoed 18x24" paper: 5 sheets
Acrylic gesso: enough to prepare 5 sheets of paper 18x24" at home before workshop...or you can bring pre-gessoed canvas from a pad

- Compressed charcoal (not charcoal pencils)
- Vine or willow charcoal
- 4B Pencil
- Small pencil sharpener
- 2 bulldog clips
- Hard plastic eraser: Blick link below, but you may purchase a similar item anywhere.

- Gloves: Optional. When we work with the with charcoal, it will get messy.
- 5 @ 2" chip brushes: Any hardware store has these brushes. Home Depot link below.
[2" chip brush Home Depot](#) (Instructor will be providing paint to use with chip brushes)
- 2 Small bowls/containers for water large enough for 2" wide chip brushes
- Rags/paper towels
- Paints and brushes that you are comfortable working with
(Oil, acrylic, or gouache) mandatory colors: White, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, and a yellow: any yellow or gold ochre
- Palette knife
