Three rooms, three shows: in the middle, a dialogue between imaginary beautiful girls drawn by Ms. Scobel and **lumpy girl heads sculptured by Ms. Mastrangelo**; to one side, paintings of dogs or cats with patterned frames on striped walls by the veteran pattern painter and sculptor Ms. Carlson; and, on the other side, mostly white, slightly eccentric Minimalist sculptures by Ms. Westermann, including an elegant simulated drinking fountain bowl (Johnson).
