FUSION

Introduction by Joyce Enen Weinstein: Artist/Curator

It is very fashionable now to build a group exhibition around a very specific theme. I call these curators shows. Artists conform to what the curator feels important. The work is selected based on whether the artist conformed to the theme or not. Some artists may even create work expressly for that theme. Entirely contrary to that way of thinking, FUSION is an artists' exhibition, an exhibition of works that exhibit a vision and point of view that has been created over time, work that is meaningful to the artist.

In curating this exhibition I was once again astounded by the variety of the human endeavor called "creativity" and the need for people to create and make things. That was the thrill for me, seeing the remarkable variation of styles, types, media, ideas and thoughts of individuals and how their personal perceptions translated into concrete objects of art. Even though I know what processes and experiences goes into making a meaningful work there is always an element of magic; that leap of the imagination that is so completely individual and mysterious.

Among the nineteen artists represented in FUSION, every style and medium and point of view is presented. All the works look different from each other although some works may have subtle connections or may act as foils for other works in the show. What better way to explain then reading how each artist has encapsulated his/her work, demonstrating the wide variety of genres?






