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A mobile home/art gallery is temporarily camped out at the base of the High Line. Inspired by the park's past life-it elevated freight trains bringing goods into the city-Cape asked the Saratoga Springsbased curator Ian Berry to load the vehicle with art from upstate. The result is a charming group show with strong work by artists such as Kenji Fujita, Michael Oatman, and Nancy Shaver and more than a few amusing juxtapositions (Rebecca Murtaugh's ornamental pendants hang in a dingy bathroom).
