Standard Space Gallery Presents: *Fields of Snakes* – Eve Biddle & Theo Coulombe

Sharon, CT — Standard Space is heart-full and heartbroken to present our final show, *Fields of Snakes*, a collaborative two-person exhibition featuring the works of Eve Biddle and gallery founder Theo Coulombe.

Fields of Snakes emphasizes the layered conversations between memory, materiality, and symbolism, highlighting how collaboration can spark new ideas when they come together. Snakes, like frogs, and landscapes both represent eternity and the perpetual, but often elusive, act of renewal. This show brings together Biddle's vessels, mirrors and jewelry with Coulombe's landscape photography, and together they embody a timelessness of place and object. Each work functions literally and metaphorically as a vessel; each a carrier of memory and history; each emphasizing the ancient and mythic qualities of serpents and land.

Coulombe and Biddle are both thrilled to be showing together as their mutual admiration goes back a decade.

About Eve Biddle

The core concept of Eve Biddle's most recent works is an exploration of site, history, and memory, reflecting her connection to Wassaic, New York, and the physical and cultural landscape it embodies. The installation derives from her layered visual language — ancient vessel forms play with the immediacy of drawing and Biddle's hand. The serpentine forms evoke mythic narratives of fertility, transformation, and protection — and these pieces can be interacted with physically as vessels in the home, word jewelry, and mirrors.

About Theo Coulombe

Theo Coulombe's photography shows his mastery of large-format analog processes, emphasizing the fundamentals of composition, tone, and detail. Painstakingly bringing them into a digital realm enables large-scale printing that delivers an epic story. His work captures quiet moments, emphasizing the beauty of our lived environment. Sharon, CT, has been his home and workplace for eight years and these photographs are a tribute to this region.
