Standard Space is supremely lucky to have Louise Sheldon's exhibition adorning our walls. When first encountering her work I wasn't sure what I was looking at and more interestingly, how the imagery, color and style drew out emotions and emotional triggers. At first there's a psychedelia tripping memories of my early 20's, flashbacks of Grateful Dead or Max Creek concerts, rainbow gatherings attended and a nostalgia of a time I longed for but never would experience, because it never existed in the pure (and simplistically youthful) sense I believed it did.

It's when you stop and actually look at the imagery that you start to see the flashbacks to faces, voices, episodes and vailed darkness emanating from Sheldon's backgrounds. You realize that fabric and pattern are glossing over the fractured memories of youthful confusion, anguish and sometimes the injury, that we're living with the fragmented legacy of becoming adults.

These flashbacks awaited me when I fixed my attention on Louise's, 'Tablecloth Mother', a watercolor from 2022. An acid green Burberry like check is optically distorted by a stain of coffee (or wine?) revealing a face and I'm immediately trying to recall a name, a memory to escape a looming sense of nostalgia and somehow - loss. But these are my memories.
